2.1 Biological Psychology Introduction to Psychology



Biological psychology also known as biopsychology or
psychobiology is the application of the principles of
biology to the study of mental processes and behaviour.
Biological psychology as a scientific discipline emerged
from a variety of scientific and philosophical traditions in
the 18th and 19th centuries.
